Solicit

- New practice, or just open
- Vet practice with exotics
- Ask pet stores
- falconers
- Not other rehabbers Vets
- Sometimes situational



Communication a must!

- Ask what they can or want to do
- Communicate costs
- Discuss your wildlife needs
- Establish protocol


Understanding Rehabilitators!

Categorize by Needs

- Vet #1 Is close but only does radiographs
- Vet #2 will see all patients, is far away and patients wait for service (busy practice)
- Vet #3 is close and will come to your facility but charges (a lot).
- Vet #4 is far, only sees certain species, but gets surgeries done lickety split!
- Vet #5 Does alternative medicine, charges but does those cases you can't make heads or tails to find treatment plan
